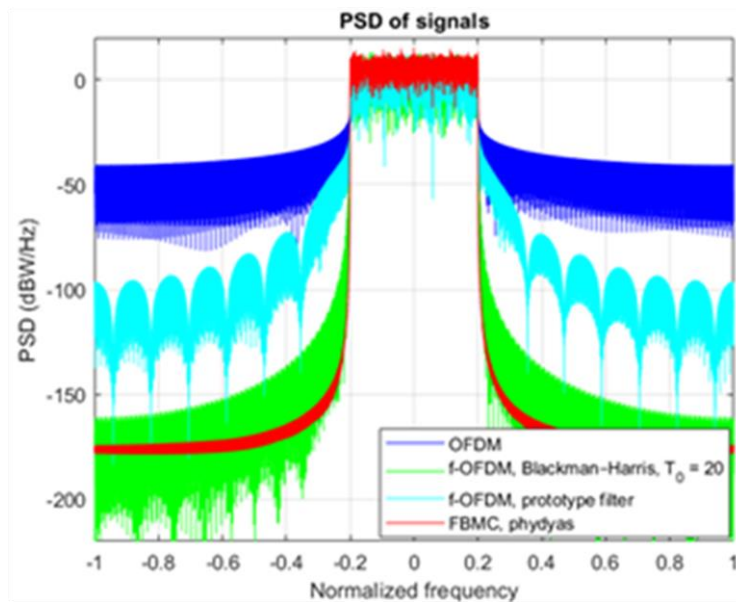

GUIDE FOR AUTHORS

1. *Journal of Military Science and Technology: Advances in Science and Technology* is mainly intended for advances in science and technology and published in May and November every year. Manuscript will be sent to two independent reviewers in the same field.
2. Submission of an article implies that the described work has not been published previously, and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. The publication is approved by all authors and will not be published elsewhere in the same form, in English or in any other language.
3. All papers must be carefully written in English (American or British usage is accepted), doubled-space with margins of A4 format (top 4 cm, bottom 2.86 cm, right 3.86 cm, left 2.5 cm, Font: Times New Roman) and two copies must be submitted to the Editorial office. Alternatively, manuscripts can be sent to contact@jmst.info or submitted to website: <https://online.jmst.info>. The length of a manuscript is normally 7 pages but no more than 12 pages; 4 pages for scientific information.
4. Manuscripts must be formatted as follows: Title, Affiliations, Abstract, Text, References. The corresponding author should be indicated and his/her contact information including address, telephone, as well as e-mail address, should be provided.
5. Article structure is as follows: The template can be downloaded at the website: <https://online.jmst.info>
 - **Title (TIMES NEW ROMAN_B_12)**: should be 100 characters including spaces or less and avoid technical terms, abbreviations, punctuation and active verbs.
 - **Authors (B_11)**: **Nguyen Van A^{1*}, Tran Ngoc B²** where indexes 1,2,.. show Affiliations, Corresponding author(s) is identified with an asterisk (*)
 - **Abstract (Italic_11)**: Approximately 150 - 250 words, provide a general introduction to the topic and a brief summary of your main results and their implication.
 - **Keywords (Normal_9)**: Immediately after the abstract, provide a maximum of 6 keywords, using American spelling and avoiding general and plural terms and multiple concepts.
 - **Main sections (B_12)**: **INTRODUCTION, ..., CONCLUSION, REFERENCES.**
 - **Methods**: The Methods section appears in all online original research articles and should contain all elements necessary for interpretation and replication of the results.
 - **Conclusion**: The main conclusion of the study may be presented in a short, which may stand alone or form a subsection of a Discussion or Results and Discussion section.
 - **Acknowledgements (optional)**: Keep acknowledgements brief and do not include thanks to secret referees or editors. Grant or contribution numbers should be acknowledged.
 - **References**: It must include the authors, the title, the year of publication, the (journal's, book's, proceeding's) name, volume, and the first page number, name of publisher and place of publication, the full name and location of the conference or workshop. The style for all reference lists for example:

 - **Figures**: must be sufficient resolution for referees to properly assess the data.
 - **Tables**. Each table should be accompanied by a short title sentence describing what the table shows. Further details can be included as footnotes to the table
 - **Math formula**: Please submit math equations as editable text and not as images. Formulae or equations must be given separate numbering and align text right.
6. Submission consisting of secret contents must be approved by the authority.
7. Any submission which violate the above regulations and reviewers' agreement will be rejected.
